**CORONAVIRUS POLICY:** With the increase in the numbers of coronavirus cases, the Archdiocese of Birmingham issued the following guidelines that oblige us to follow:

- Holy Communion under one kind and on the hand only
- Handshaking or other direct physical contact during the sign of peace is suspended
- We cease use of shared hymn books. The papers that have been used during liturgy (Sunday liturgy sheet and parish newsletter) have to be disposed by everyone after Mass into the basket which is in the church porch
- Everyone who is attending Mass is asked to sanitise hands as you come into church using sanitized gel dispensers at porch
- Church door handles must be cleaned with antibacterial wipes regularly before and after every Mass. We need volunteers to do it please
- Tea/coffee after 11am Mass is suspended
- The collectors are asked to sanitise their hands before and after taking the collections
- Anyone with cold or flu symptoms and most vulnerable (elderly, people with weakened immune systems and long-term conditions like cancer, diabetes and heart disease) are asked to refrain from attending Liturgy
- Those counting the money should wash their hands before and after counting
- Public veneration of relics and the Cross on Good Friday will not be by kissing or physically touching them
