The icon was made by artist Mulugeta Araya in Ethiopia, and it interprets Jesus' teaching of healing and liberation in the Synagogue in Luke 4:16-21, which refers to Isaiah 61:1-2. This passage is particularly relevant to the Jubilee, given its emphasis on bringing Good News to those who are poor, and liberty to those who are captive or oppressed.
